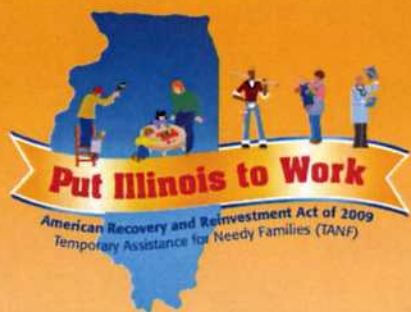




Put Illinois to Work



Put Illinois to Work is a statewide initiative aimed at stimulating the economy and local job market by creating thousands of job opportunities.

Through *Put Illinois to Work*, HHCS will:

- Recruit workers
- Pay workers comp and Social Security
- Maintain payroll

All employers, public, private, and non-profit, are encouraged to participate except those who*:

- Participate in illegal activities
- Produce/sell adult entertainment
- Engage in the sale of weapons or liquor as a primary business

*Other restrictions may apply.

Employers... Expand Your Business With Put Illinois To Work!

Put Illinois to Work is a program created by Illinois Governor Pat Quinn and the Illinois Department of Human Services. This program, utilizing state funds and federal stimulus dollars, will be administered in partnership with Heartland Human Care Services, Inc® (HHCS) and the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity to provide subsidized wages for eligible unemployed, low-income parents and young adults throughout Illinois. Employers offering entry-level positions are needed to host subsidized workers for up to six months, ending September 30, 2010.

Benefits offered by *Put Illinois to Work* include:

- **NO wage expenses for employers**
- The opportunity to train new workers on your unique internal processes/procedures
- The option to hire skilled workers after September 30, 2010
